

RODEO: Utah Days of '47 Rodeo 2023

CITY: Salt Lake City, Utah

DATES: July 19-24, 2023

SLACK: July 10-11, 2023

### **Breakaway**

- Entries limited to 150 contestants. Qualifications: 105 from the 2023 Pro Rodeo Breakaway World Standings based on winnings seven days prior to entry closing; 45 from the 2023 Pro Rodeo Breakaway Wilderness Circuit Standings based on winnings seven days prior to entry closing. The "30 hour replacement policy" will be in effect.
- Entry Fee \$371 (\$350 entry fee +\$21 Procom Fee). No stock charge.
- Format will be: Two Rounds + a Progressive (40) and a Finals (8)
- Qualifying slack will be held July 11, 2023, at the Days of 47' Arena. Two Rounds, reverse order for second round. The top 40 in the average after the first two go-rounds will advance to the progressive round (will not exceed 40) held during the first four performances (10 per performance).
- Qualifying Slack Advancement Tie Breakers: Ties will be broken by taking the single fastest time from the qualifying go rounds. If still tied will take the highest ranked contestant in the 2023 WPRA Pro Rodeo Breakaway World Standings based on winnings seven days prior to entry closing.
- Performance preferences for the progressive will be accepted by the rodeo secretary in writing within one (1) hour following the end of the second go round for LBK in the qualifying slack. The priority list will be determined by the fastest time on two (AVE) for LBK. Contestant will receive her first preference, and if not available, will receive her second preference prior to moving to the next contestant on the priority list.
- Progressive round trades – After the progressive performance positions are posted, contestants will have until 5 PM MDT on July 12, 2023, to complete trades with the rodeo secretary. Competition positions will be randomly drawn by judges after the trade deadline for each progressive performance.
- Replacements in the progressive performances will be made for any TO/DR/DO/VIR/TONN from the next eligible contestant based on the AVE from the qualifying slack. Procom and the rodeo secretary will work together to replace from the eligible contestants until performance time.
- The top 2 contestants based on fastest times in that respective performance will advance to the Finals (Gold Medal Round). Replacements will be made from the vacated qualifier's performance.
- Progressive Round Advancement Tie Breakers: If there are fewer than 2 qualified times in that performance, then the replacement will be the next fastest time from any of the progressive performances. Ties will be broken by the average from the qualifying slack, then the single fastest time in any previous round, then judge's coin toss.
- Competition order in Finals will be random.

### **Barrel Racing**

- Entries limited to 200 contestants. Qualifications: 150 will be selected from 2023 Pro Rodeo Barrel Racing World Standings based on winnings seven days prior to entry closing. 10 will be selected from the 2022 WPRA Tour Standings. 20 will be selected from 2023 WPRA/PRCA Wilderness Circuit Standings based on winnings seven days prior to entry closing. 20 will be selected from 2022 WPRA/PRCA Wilderness Circuit Standings. The "30 hour replacement policy" will be in effect.
- Entry Fee \$371 (\$350 entry fee +\$21 Procom Fee).

- Format will be: One Round + a Progressive (40) and a Finals (8)
- Qualifying slack will be held July 12, 2023, at the Days' of 47' Arena. The top 40 from the first round will advance to the progressive round (will not exceed 40) held during the first four performances (10 per performance).
- Qualifying Slack Advancement Tie Breakers: Ties will be broken by taking the highest placing contestant in the 2023 WPRA Pro Rodeo World Standings based on winnings seven days prior to entry closing.
- Performance preferences for the progressive will be accepted by the rodeo secretary in writing within one (1) hour following the end of the first go round for GBR. The priority list will be determined by the top 40 times in the GBR. The contestant will receive her first preference, and if not available, will receive her second preference prior to moving to the next contestant on the priority list.
- Progressive Round Trades – After the progressive performance positions are posted, contestants will have until 5 PM MDT on July 12, 2023, to complete trades with the rodeo secretary. Competition positions will be randomly drawn by judges after the trade deadline for each progressive performance.
- Replacements in the progressive performances will be made for any TO/DR/DO/VIR/TONN from the next eligible contestant based on the times from the qualifying slack. Procom and the rodeo secretary will work together to replace from the eligible contestants until performance time.
- The top 2 contestants based on fastest times in that respective performance will advance to the Finals (Gold Medal Round). Replacements will be made from the vacated qualifier's performance.
- Progressive Round Advancement Tie Breakers: If there are fewer than 2 qualified times in that performance, then the replacement will be the next fastest time from any of the progressive performances. Ties will be broken by the single fastest time in the qualifying slack, then judges coin toss.
- Competition order in Finals will be random.
- Condensed drag (5) in slack per rule 12.8.2.1.1. Drag after 5 in progressive performances & hand rake after each contestant. Drag after 4 in finals and hand rake after each contestant.

### **Payoff**

Qualifying Round(s) Payoff- See attached example for payout scales.

Barrel 1 Go

Breakaway 2 Go & Average

Progressive Payoff Per Performance:

1st - \$2,000

2nd - \$1,500

3rd - \$1,000

4th- \$500.

Finals Payoff:

1st - \$10,000

2nd - \$7,000

3rd - \$4,500

4th – \$2,000

5th - \$500

6th - \$500  
7th - \$500  
8th - \$500.

Qualifiers in the final round will earn the payoff, with or without a time. If fewer than 4 qualified times, the placings will be determined by: 1) single fastest time in the progressive round, then 2) the AVE (LBK only), then 3) the fastest single time in qualifying rounds. If tie cannot be broken, monies will be split evenly.

Awards only final tiebreaker will be the contestant with the highest ranking based on 2023 money won as of WPRA Pro Rodeo World Standings based on winnings seven days prior to entry closing.

### **General**

- Only actual contestant and one companion allowed gate access. Companion tickets will be sold at a discount to contestants needing additional tickets at check-in.
- Contestants must wear back numbers provided by the Days of '47. The back number must be visible outside a vest or jacket.
- Stalls: Days of '47 Arena – Utah State Fairpark has limited stalls and hookups available at no charge. Stalls are first come, first served. Contestants are asked to utilize stalls for the night they are competing, then move out by 9 AM the following day to accommodate the next set of contestants.
- Pushers and other helpers must be credentialed from the rodeo secretary's office. To obtain credentials, the individual must be a member of the WPRA/PRCA with WPRA/PRCA insurance dues paid for the current year.
