Ground Rules:

- 1 Your entry and or attendance is your agreement to follow all rules, regulations and policies put in place by Producer, Producers Agents, and Facility. It is your responsibility to familiarize yourself with the rules.
- 2 Contestants must be ready to compete when called upon. Enter through the alley, exit via side gate. Failure to be at the gate ready to compete will result in disqualification and forfeiture of all fees. No circling in the arena.
- 3 No switching of draw positions without prior permission of the office.
- 4 Full dress code including long sleeved shirt, cowboy hat or helmet, boots, and jeans is required for all competition runs.

- 5 Reruns are only awarded in the case of a timer malfunction. You will be granted to option to rerun at the end of the race or receive a refund of entry fee.
- 6 60-second time limit for exhibitions.
- 7 Awards and earnings must be claimed the day of the race or arrangements made with the producer.
- 8 A hit barrel is a no time. Broken patterns result in a no time.
- 9 No excessive spurring, jerking, whipping, abuse with any device, or any action which intends to cause harm.
- 10 Unsportsmanlike conduct, dishonesty, harassment, or threatening behavior will NOT be tolerated. The Producer, in its sole discretion, has the right to immediately, and without prior notice or warning, disqualify a contestant and forfeit all monies.
- 11 Producer reserves the right to make modifications, changes, or adjustments to the event schedules, rules, or procedures if necessary.
- 12 In the case of inclement weather, a rain date may be set at sole discretion of the producer.
- 13 Decisions made by the producer, its directors, officers, agents, or volunteers shall be final and binding on all parties.
