2024 PUYALLUP RODEO GROUND RULES IN ADDITION AND NOT TO CONFLICT WITH THE 2024 CINCH PLAYOFFS GROUND RULES:

Competition Format: Limit 24 two go's with top 8/4 finals on Sunday.

All events: The "30-hour replacement" rule will be in effect.

TE: If a timed event animal escapes (or a re-run is due for any other reason) the extra will be used. Only escaped animals go back into the heard.

Re-Rides: After all replacements have been made, any remaining available animals that were notified as turned-out (includes DR's and VIR's) will be used as re-rides prior to using the designated re-ride(s).

All contestants: Each contestant will be given a back number which must be worn and displayed at all times while in competition area.

CONTESTANT CAMPING/PARKING AREA WILL OPEN AT 6:00 AM ON TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 3, 2024. EACH CONTESTANT WILL BE GIVEN A PARKING HANG TAG WHICH MUST BE DESPLAYED IN VEHICLE AT ALL TIMES. ALL TIMED EVENT PARKING WILL BE IN A SPECIFIC LOCATION AND EACH CONTESTANT WILL BE ALLOTED ONE DESIGNATED PARKING SPACE. ALL CONTESTANTS MUST CHECK IN WITH THE PARKING ATTENDANT PRIOR TO PARKING TO CONFIRM THEIR DESINATED LOCATION. CONTESTANT CAMPING/PARKING AREA IS FOR CONTESTANTS ONLY NOT FOR VISITING FRIENDS OR FAMILY SPACE IS LIMITED.

The Puyallup Rodeo will not be providing stalls for contestants.

Only actual contestant and one companion allowed gate access. Companions and children are to stay in contestant hospitality area or grandstand seating prior to, during and after the rodeo and not behind chutes, staging area or in arena after performance.

Contestants with horses are to parade across from the camping/parking lot through the livestock gate on the fairgrounds to the arena in the main grandstand up to 1.5 hours prior to the start of the rodeo perf. Contestants **must follow** the contestant escort/shuttle, for safety no single riders.

Contestants with horses are to stay on the designated contestant escort/shuttle route to the arena and not wonder on fairgrounds. Rodeo Committee has clean-up crew scheduled for designated route.

The Committee is requesting highest score/fastest time contestants to remain in arena following matinee performances on Saturday 9/7 for autograph session and the Playoff Champions on Sunday to remain for autograph session in the arena.
