BARREL RACING and BREAKAWAY ROPING

The 2025 SSPRS will consist of ten (10) Pro Rodeos with WPRA Barrel Racing and six (6) Pro Rodeos for WPRA Breakaway Roping. Dates below:

Dates for the Barrel Racing will be: June 20-21, June 27-28, July 3-4-5, July 11-12, July 18-19, July 25-26, August 1-2, August 8-9, August 15-16, August 22-23, 2025.

Dates for the Breakaway Roping will be: July 18-19, July 25-26, August 1-2, August 8-9, August 15-16, August 22-23, 2025.

*The WPRA Barrel Race will offer \$2,000.00 added money for each Rodeo, EXCEPT, \$4,000.00 will be added to the July 3rd, 4th, and 5th Rodeo. WPRA Breakaway Roping will offer \$2,000.00 added money for each Rodeo.

WPRA Barrel Race will host twelve (12) Racers per performance with dragging ground after every six (6) racers.

WPRA Barrel Race Slack will be every Friday night after the Rodeo, EXCEPT, slack will be held on Thursday, July 3rd for this weeks performance.

WPRA Breakaway is limited to forty (40) contestants per Rodeo.

Both WPRA Barrel Race and WPRA Breakaway is co-approved with the Wilderness Circuit.

During applicable Rodeos when timed event entries require redraws, timed event redraws will be completed prior to slack beginning.

Issued back numbers must be worn.

Warm up in the main arena is prohibited within two (2) hours prior of the performance. A warm up arena is provided.

Dress code shall apply one (1) hour prior to each performance. Denim dress attire is allowed.

Only the actual contestant and one (1) companion will be allowed free gate access, and current WPRA card holders who are not competing, are allowed free gate access.

The Series season winner, in each event, will receive a 2025 Champion Belt Buckle.

The Series also includes Junior and Pee Wee barrel racing each Rodeo performance (using a different pattern), after the twelve (12) WPRA Barrel Racers complete their run in the performance.

Stalls will be available for rent for \$20.00 per night and reservations can be made in advance by calling 970-819-7838. Stalls will only be available to contestants who are entered in that week's Rodeo. Only rental of stalls or tying up to your trailers are allowed. Contestants will abide by parking rules posted at the office.
