## **Great Lakes Circuit Breakaway Divisional Circuit Finals**

## **Ground Rules**

- 1. Draw from the WPRA Rule book for all rules
- 2. WPRA GLC Breakaway Roping DC finals sidepot qualifications The top 12 WPRA GLC Breakaway Roping card holders from the WPRA GLC Breakaway Roping DC standings will be invited to enter the GLC Breakaway Roping DC Finals. If the 12 positions are not filled it will drop down to the highest money earner in the WPRA GLC Breakaway Roping Rodeo standings who entered the DC Finals, then if the 12 positions are still not filled it will drop down to the highest money earning WPRA GLC Permit holder who entered the DC Finals.
- 3. If there is a NTO or Release at least 24hours prior to the jackpot, the open position will be filled with the next eligible contestant who entered the DC finals (DC/Pro Rodeo/Permit). Within 24 hours of the DC Finals it is not guaranteed the spot will be filled.
- 4. The WPRA GLC Breakaway Roping DC Finals will be a sidepot to the open jackpot.
- 5. The WPRA GLC Breakaway Roping DC Finals contestants <u>must</u> enter the open jackpot, in order to be able to enter the WPRA GLC Breakaway Roping DC Finals sidepot.
- 6. There will be a \$10 office fee that is given to the producer for allowing the WPRA GLC Breakaway Roping DC Finals to be included as a sidepot to their open jackpot.
- 7. Total entry fees for the GLC DC sidepot will be \$160 (\$150 in the pot & \$10 barn fee to producer)
- 8. Added money of \$1000, is sponsored by Wrangler.
- 9. The payoff will be as following
  - \$150.00 to the fastest time in each round (3 rounds)
  - It will pay 4 places on the 3 head average (40%, 30%, 20%, 10%)
    - o 1st \$940
    - o 2nd \$705
    - o 3rd \$470
    - o 4th \$235
- 10. The Open Jackpot is enter twice The WPRA GLC breakaway Roping DC Finals Contestants will have to designate their A or B run, to count for the WPRA GLC Breakaway Roping DC Finals standings, if they choose to enter twice. This can be done onsite when paying entry fees to the secretary. If not designated, the A run will be picked automatically.
