GROUND RULES

For April 23rd – 26th, 2026

1. **ALL Events:** The “30-Hour replacement” rule will be in effect. See rodeo entry information page of the business journal.
2. **ALL Events:** The “Walk-up replacement” policy will be in effect. See rodeo entry information page of the business journal.
3. **All Events:** Re-entries will be accepted for available positions on (Need date and time) See rodeo entry information page of the business journal.
4. **TRADE DEADLINE: (DATE AND TIME)** All confirmed trades will final and will be processed immediately after both involved parties have confirmed through PROCOM
5. **ALL CONTESTANTS:** Rodeo contestant parking for all contestants pulling trailers will be at 10530 Vine Street, “The Hay Guy”. Rodeo contestant parking for Passenger vehicles to be located at El Capitan High School (designated area), This may be entered via Vine Street Lakeside CA, directly west of Rodeo Grounds to start at 3:00 PM, Thursday, April 23rd, and end just after the rodeo on Sunday, April 26th, 2026. (Signage will direct contestants) No alcohol or tobacco products in this area please (California school rules). This area is adjacent to the Rodeo Grounds. Contestants may not stall their animals on the Rodeo Grounds without written permission of the Rodeo Committee.
6. Primary Slack parking for Thursday, April 23rd, 2026, will be the Rodeo Grounds main parking lot @ 12584 Mapleview St. (no trailer clean-outs at this area). One trailer and vehicle per contestant only. All contestants will vacate this parking area no later than 2:00 PM, on Thursday, April 23st, 2026, and move to the primary contestant parking area at 10530 Vine Street, “The Hay Guy” (Rule #1).
7. Contestant parking prior to Thursday, April 23st, 2026, will have to be arranged through the Rodeo Committee at 619-561-4331.
8. TD, SW, TR – will be one go-round regardless of the number of entries. TD – There will be a disqualification for a jerk down as long as all of the criteria are in compliance with the jerk down policy. QUALIFICATIONS: BB & SB – 48 minimum entries. No compensation. No Slack. BR – 60 minimum entries. No compensation. No slack.
9. Contestants will not tie horses or any other livestock to any chain link fence at any time. There will be no exceptions.
10. The Main Arena will be cleared 15 Minutes prior to each performance.
