WPRA SANCTIONING RIDER

The Buccaneer Commission (dba Rodeo Corpus Christi) agrees to the 2026, 2027, 2028 WPRA ProRodeo Sanctioning Agreements with the following amendments:

I. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY, SPONSORSHIP, MARKETING AND MERCHANDISE RIGHTS

a. Rights Remain in Rodeo Corpus Christi

i. Rodeo Corpus Christi retains all intellectual property, sponsorship, marketing and merchandise rights associated with its marks, its presentations, the actual conduct of its events and the live production and on-site presentation of its shows and competitions to include rodeo events, awards presentations, and contestant recognition.

1. Intellectual Property:

a. While respecting the intellectual property right of contestants, Rodeo Corpus Christi retains all rights associated with its still footage/photography, closed-circuit broadcasts and distribution as follows:

i. Rodeo Corpus Christi retains all rights in and to the filming, taping, recording in any media now or hereafter known, still footage/photography, television, radio or internet broadcasting or reproduction in any manner or form thereof of May 4-9, 2026, 2027 (Dates TBD), 2028 (Dates TBD) Rodeo Corpus Christi Events.

ii. Rodeo Corpus Christi currently has a media rights agreement with PBR and intends to work with WPRA on a media rights agreement that is mutually beneficial to Rodeo Corpus Christi, WPRA, and PBR.

III. RODEO CORPUS CHRISTI ENTRY PROCESS

a. Contestant Limits: Each event will consist of the following contestants/teams.

1. Barrel Racing: 60
2. Breakaway Roping: 60

*All contestants must be in good standing with the WPRA and Rodeo Corpus Christi.

IV. PRIZE MONEY

a. Rodeo Corpus Christi will offer the following Added Money:

1. Barrel Racing: \$50,000
 2. Breakaway Roping: \$50,000
- b. TOTAL ADDED MONEY: \$100,000

V. COMPETITION FORMAT

a. Breakaway Roping

i. There will be 60 maximum entries.

1. One go-round will be held during the first four performances.
2. There will be 8 contestant outs per performance during the go-round.
3. The top 12 contestants after the go-round will be placed in the Finals
4. If animal escapes the confines of the Arena when the contestant is still eligible to compete, the flag will be dropped and contestant must take the next extra in the draw.

b. Barrel Racing

i. 60 maximum number of entries

1. One go-round will be held during the first four performances
2. There will be 8 contestant outs per performance during the go-round .
3. The top 12 contestants after the go-round will be placed in the Finals.

c. All other rules will be enforced per the WPRA rulebook.

VI. STALLS & PARKING

a. Stalls are available for rent at the Richard M. Borchard Regional Fairgrounds in Robstown. Please contact the Fairgrounds at (361) 387-9000 to reserve your stall.

b. Stalls are NOT available at the Performances in Corpus Christi at the Hilliard Center. Contestants are to park in the Contestant parking area located. A map of parking area will be distributed to contestants.

VII. GENERAL RULES

- a. Contestants with horses must check in with the Rodeo Secretary and present current required Texas Animal Health Commission documents.
- b. Each contestant must complete and sign a Rodeo Corpus Christi Release of Liability, Indemnity and Background Check Agreement and present it to the Rodeo Secretary prior to his/her first competition.
- c. Each contestant will be furnished with a Rodeo Corpus Christi back number, which must be worn or displayed in its entirety at all times when in the Competition Arena. If a contestant has an existing patch sponsorship involving the cantle/yoke of the shirt, then the contestant may wear the Rodeo Corpus Christi back number immediately below the existing cantle/yoke patch. If a contestant elects to wear a protective vest or jacket then that contestant must wear the Rodeo Corpus Christi back number in the same location on the vest or jacket.
- d. In accordance with PRCA Bylaws (B15.1.9), this is to notify that Rodeo Corpus Christi will only admit contestants who are entered in the competition to all facilities at no charge. PRCA members who are not entered will not be given free admission, nor may they enter any area restricted only to contestants without proper Rodeo Corpus Christi credentials.
- e. No family members (including children), guests, escorts, etc. will be allowed in chute or arena floor areas.
- f. No dogs will be allowed on the grounds, with the exception of contract acts.
- g. If an animal escapes, use the extra.
- h. If a turnout occurs draw for a re-ride.

VIII. APPEARANCES, PRESS AND MEDIA

- a.) Contestants agree to be available to Rodeo Corpus Christi staff for media interviews during the days/evenings that they are participating in Rodeo Corpus Christi.
