Ground Rules for Prineville  
June 24 – 27, 2026

Ground Rules: Only actual contestant with a PRCA or WPRA card and one companion allowed gate access through "Contestants Gate," off Fairgrounds Blvd. on east side of the grounds. Ticket will be required at all other entrances.

ALL EVENTS – The "30-hour replacement," policy will be in effect. See Rodeo Entry Information Section of the Business Journal.

ALL EVENTS – The "walkup replacement," policy will be in effect. See Rodeo Entry Information Section of the Business Journal.

ALL EVENTS – Re-entries will be accepted for available positions on Wednesday, June 24, 2026, between 9 AM and 11 AM. See Rodeo Entry Information Page of the Business Journal.

TIMED EVENT TRADE DEADLINE – Thursday June 25, 2026. All confirmed trades will be final and will be processed immediately after both involved parties have confirmed through PROCOM.

BA – Electric eye barrier will be used.

BA – Contestant must use pusher provided to bring cattle down the lane.

BA - If a timed event animal escapes during a performance or a re-run is awarded for any other reason during a performance, the extra will be used. Only escaped animals go back into the herd.

BA - Breakaway cattle will be drawn

SLACK ORDER

BARRELS – Wednesday, June 24 at 8:00 pm

TE SLACK ORDER – Thursday, June 25 & Friday June 26 SW, TD, BA, TR.

SCORE LENGTH - BA – 14 feet. The length of the roping box is approximately 50 feet. Contestants must use the pusher provided to bring cattle down the lane.

BA - One go-round. The contestants with the 12 fastest times will be placed in the performance. (The slowest time will run first. The fastest time will run last.)

If splits result in more than 12, a random draw will determine which contestants will compete in the performance and which will compete in slack. The order of competition of ties from the first go-round will also be determined by random draw. If there are not 12 qualified times from the first go-round, to fill the performance, the remaining positions will be filled by contestants based on the reverse order of their first go-round positions (only contestants who competed in the first go-round will be placed in the performance.) the remaining contestants (not placed in the performance) will run their second go-round in the slack immediately following the completion of the first go-round position. The order of the draw will be the same as the competition order.
