Walk up Replacement will NOT be accepted at this event

**Contestant Info:**

1. NO contestant horse trailers or vehicles are allowed to cross the track and nor are they allowed to park in the infield. Contestant parking is located on the east side of the track indicated by "contestant parking" signs. You must walk on foot across the track and be able to provide your pro card to security and the parking attendants. If you need to cross the track in a vehicle, you MUST use the bridge on the west side of the track. Do not drive across the track with out the bridge on.
2. DO NOT drive across the track if you DO NOT have an infield pass.
3. NO garbage or manure is to be left in the contestant parking area when you leave. Use provided garbage bins and manure dump areas indicated with signs. There will be no wheel barrow provided
4. NO tying horses or bracing panels to the track fence or the chain link fence along the road.

5. NO pop up barrels in the arena at any time.
6. NO running horses on a barrel pattern.
7. The arena will ONLY be available for open riding on slack day from 8am-9am on June 4, 2026
8. The arena will ONLY be available for open riding on performance days from 11am-12pm on June 5, 2026 and from 10am-11am on June 6-7, 2026
9. Horses may be warmed up in the infield in the grassed area on the south side. NO pop up barrels.
10. There will be no pre-conditioning of any timed event cattle. They will run through the chute by the judges and committee to be shown the arena and out gate.
11. All horses are to be kept outside of the rodeo arena 2 hours prior to and during slack and performances, and while the tractor is in the infield. Only the next contestant to go is to have their horse(s) in arena.
12. Contestants and companions MUST produce their valid 2026 CPRA pro card to enter the grounds and infield. They must always keep it on their person.
13. Pro card will give you access to all general admission and VIP areas of our grounds, but you will need to produce it when asked or you will not be allowed entry.
14. Any disrespect or abuse towards rodeo committee and/or volunteers will NOT be tolerated, and you will be removed from our grounds whether the incident occurs before, during or after our event. This will be strictly enforced by pro rodeo officials and the RASA committee.
