

Animal Entry Requirements for the Shakopee MN rodeo July 17-19 2026

HEALTH CERTIFICATES

All horses (including pony/outrider horses) entering the grounds for the first time must have an original health certificate (Certificate of Veterinary Inspection) issued within five (5) days of their arrival and a negative Coggins Test Certificate issued within twelve (12) months of arrival. Equine rhinopneumonitis (EHV-1 and EHV-4) and Influenza vaccination dates, specific product used, and expiration date and rectal temperatures for each horse should be included on the health certificate.

VACCINATIONS

Every horse entering the enclosure of the racetrack must have been vaccinated by a veterinarian with an FDA approved modified live or killed virus vaccine specific for EHV-1 and EHV-4 and Influenza not less than 14 days and not more than 180 days prior to date of entry. The specific product used and expiration date as well as the date the horse was vaccinated must appear on the health certificate. Horses must be vaccinated no later than July 1, 2026.

ALL OTHER ANIMALS

All other animals will require a health certificate. No specific requirement on those but event hired veterinarian should know the information needed. Those should be completed by July 1st 2026

All health certificates with vaccination information and a negative Coggins test certificate must be submitted to Andrew Vold no later than July 1st 2026. Certificates can be submitted via email or photos of documents can be sent via text to the information.
