

2026- Amarillo Tri-State Rodeo Ground Rules WPRA

Committee requests that entries not open before Labor Day, September 7, 2026.

Co-approve with following circuits: Turquoise, and Prairie.

RE – Card and permit holder substitution for all doctor releases, draw outs and notified turnouts received prior to 12 PM, Friday, September 11, 2026. Card and permit holder substitution re-entries 1-4 PM, Friday, September 11, 2026.

No walk-up entries will be accepted at this rodeo in 2026.

LB- All LB slack will be held on Wednesday, September 23, 2026 at 10:00 am. Ten (10) contestants will be placed in each of three performances.

GB – All GB slack will be held on Wednesday, September 23, 2026 following the Ladies Breakaway. Ten (10) contestants will be placed in each of the three performances.

SR – Three (3) go-rounds held during slack on Tuesday, Sept 22, 2026 at 10:00 am. Stock Charge according to 2025 rulebook.

TR, SW & TD – Slack will be held on Thursday, Sept. 24, 2026 at 8:00 AM. Ten (10) contestants will be placed in each of three performances. Committee requests that slack order be TR, SW & TD.

Qualifications:

BB & SB – 45 minimum entries. No slack & no compensation.

BR – 60 minimum entries. No slack & no compensation.

ALL EVENTS : All contestants will need to purchase a stall at the stall office for \$20/night for all events and includes up to 2 bags of shavings, depending on stall. A hard copy printed negative 12 month coggins test required for admittance to fairgrounds. No stall reservations. All stalls for rodeo contestants available on a first come-first serve basis in the Kimble #1 Building. No horses in portable stalls/panels for any reason. No horses tied to trailers overnight. No outside shavings allowed on fairgrounds. Any shavings should be received from grounds stall office. All contestant's trailers must be parked in specified rodeo parking area. All contestants should enter fairgrounds at Gate # 3 located on the north side of fairgrounds, which is 1 block west of 3rd and Grand intersection.

Horses that arrive without appropriate paperwork will not be permitted to unload.
