

Greeley Stampede 2026 Ground Rules

Barrel Racing

- ENTRY FEE \$316 (\$295 entry fee + \$21 Procom Fee).
- Payout per WPRA Rulebook for 2 go-rounds, finals and average.
- Format will be: One Round + a Progressive 60 and a Finals (fastest 12 on two)
- Qualifying slack will be held June 25 8:00 am, 2026. The top 60 from the first round will advance to the progressive round (will not exceed 60) held during the first five performances (12 per performance).
- If there is a tie for the top 60 advancing to the progressive round, the tie will be broken by taking the highest placing contestant in the 2026 WPRA Pro Rodeo World Standings as of seven days prior to entries closing.
- The top 60 will progress into the five performances with a random draw for positions in each performance after trades are complete.
- Progressive Round Trades – After the progressive performance positions are posted, contestants will have one hour to complete trades with the rodeo secretary. Competition positions for the progressive performances will be randomly drawn by the secretary after the trade deadline.
- Top 12 in Finals will be a random draw.
- If there is a tie for the top 12 advancing to the finals, the tie will be broken by taking the contestant with the single fastest time from either of the first go rounds. If still tied, it will be broken by taking the highest placing contestant in the 2026 WPRA Pro Rodeo World Standings as of seven days prior to entries closing.
- Condensed drag after six (6). All notified turnouts and releases from each performance and slack will be taken out of the draw after the turnout deadline. Positions will move up and be posted at the rodeo office before the rodeo begins. I.E. If you are number 9 and there are 2 releases prior to you, you will then be number 7. The committee will drag at 6 or fewer. **any notified turnouts who do reverse their turnout with the rodeo secretary will run at the end of their performance/slack with no additional dragging for them.
- PRCA/WPRA Dress Code enforced during performances and slack. The arena is considered to start at the wall of the arena on the west end and from the back of the roping boxes across to fence around the east end. Stampede provided back numbers must be worn during ticketed rodeo performances.
- Limited arena grandstand seating admission for contestant and one companion. Credentials available from rodeo secretary.
- Contestants are required to abide by safety protocols and guidelines as stated in the Rodeo Secretary Office.
- Contestants are required to complete a Stampede “waiver of liability” form prior to receiving Stampede provided back number and competing on site.
- All contestants are required to park in designated parking area – no exceptions!
- Please use the trailer clean out areas provided.
- No ride times in the main arena. A warm-up arena is provided.

Greeley Stampede 2026 Ground Rules

Breakaway

- Entries limited to 125 contestants. Qualifications: Top 44 from 2025 Pro Rodeo Breakaway World Standings. Top 44 from 2026 Pro Rodeo Breakaway World Standings based on winnings seven days prior to entry closing. Top 19 from the 2025 Pro Rodeo Breakaway Mountain States Circuit Standings. Top 18 from the 2026 Pro Rodeo Breakaway Mountain States Circuit Standings based on winnings seven days prior to entry closing. The "30-Hour Replacement" Policy will be in effect.
- Entry Fee \$256 (\$210 entry fee + \$21 Procom Fee + \$25 Stock Charge).
- Payout per WPRA Rulebook for 1 go, finals and average (11.1.6.1.)
- Format will be: One Rounds and a Finals (12)
- Slack to be held on June 24 at 8:00am.
- If there is a tie for the top 12 advancing to the Finals, it will be broken by using WPRA rule 10.3.5.5. Competition order in Finals will be placed slowest to fastest.
- When the arena is cleared for the next competition, athlete has 45 seconds to call for timed event chute gate to open. Contestant will receive three verbal time notifications and be given a "NO TIME" if time reaches 65 seconds.
- If an animal escapes the timed event chute(or a rerun is given for any other reason), the 1st extra will be used and will run last immediately after the event section. Only escaped animals return to the herd.
- PRCA/WPRA Dress Code enforced during performances and slack. The arena is considered to start at the wall of the arena on the west end and from the back of the roping boxes across to fence around east end. Stampede provided back numbers must be worn during ticketed rodeo performances.
- Limited arena grandstand seating admission for contestant and one companion. Credentials available from rodeo secretary.
- Contestants are required to abide by safety protocols and guidelines as stated in the Rodeo Secretary Office.
- Contestants are required to complete a Stampede "waiver of liability" form prior to receiving Stampede provided back number and competing on site.
