WPRA Ground Rules

Breakaway

1. Only actual contestant and one companion allowed free gate admission.
2. Slack will run in order – TD, SW, TR, BA. Contestants expected to be ready.
3. If a timed event animal escapes or a re-run is given for any other reason during a performance, the extra will be used. Only escaped animals will go back into the herd.
4. Same barrier and scorer as PRCA Tie Down Roping will be used.
5. One complete go-round will be run in slack on Tuesday, September 1, 2026. Top 45 will advance to progressive go-rounds held during performances Friday, Saturday, Sunday, September 4, 5, 6, 2026 (15 per per).
6. Contestants requested to participate in fast time and high-point ride sponsor flag victory lap following each event performance.
7. Contestants requested to participate with appropriate dress for Tough Enough to Wear Pink performance Friday, September 4, Law Enforcement and First Responder Night performance Saturday, September 5, and Patriots and Veterans performance Sunday, September 6, 2026.
8. Only contestant competing allowed in arena. All other contestants are to remain out of arena.
9. There may be an aircraft flyover at the beginning of each performance.
10. No limit on entries and all cards are welcome if acceptable to WPRA and Event Director.
11. Fifteen (15) runs per performance.
12. No parking on gravel fire lanes.
13. Arena will be closed from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.
14. Contestant pens for horses are to be no longer than your trailer and no more than 8' wide.
