

Resorts World Championship Breakaway Presented By CINCH Rules

This event is open to invitation and Short-Go Ropers of the ALL IN Breakaway only.

- **Entry Fees:**

- Invitationals Roper's entry fee is \$1,000. If you are an ALL IN Breakaway Short-Go Roper there will not be an entry fee.
Reminder: All entries must be paid in full by November 15th, 2022.
- Entry Fees includes:
 - Entry into the ALL IN Breakaway Roping which includes 3 Go-Rounds based on roping format detailed below.
 - One 10x10 stall for 3 days for one horse including one bag of shavings.
 - Open Arena time from 5-6pm each Go-Round

- **Roping Format**

- December 7-9, 2022
 - Round 1: Wednesday, December 7, 2022
 - Start time- 6PM PST at Resorts World, Las Vegas Nevada (Start time subject to change)
 - Contestants rope in draw order beginning with #1.
 - Example- #1 - #56
 - Each Entry will rope 1 calf per round, there will be two rounds
 - Payout will be determined by the fastest time, top 4 fastest times will be paid out per round
 - Round 2: Thursday, December 8, 2022

- Start time- 6PM PST at Resorts World, Las Vegas Nevada (Start time subject to change)
 - Contestants rope in draw order beginning with #56.
 - Example- #56-#1
 - Each Entry will rope 1 calf per round, there will be two rounds
 - Payout will be determined by the fastest time, top 4 fastest times will be paid out per round
 - Round 3: Friday, December 9, 2022
 - Start time- 6PM PST at Resorts World, Las Vegas Nevada (Start time subject to change)
 - Contestants rope in draw order beginning with #1.
 - Example- #1-#56
 - Each Entry will rope ONLY 1 calf this round.
 - Payout will be determined by the fastest time, top 4 fastest times will be paid out.
 - End of Round 3 there will be an average taken from the 5 calves the top 6 average times will be paid out on the average payout

- ● **Event Rules**
 - ◦ Check-in
 - ■ December 7, 2022
 - ● Stalls Check In
 - For the ALL IN Breakaway girls, the ALL IN Breakaway team will be responsible letting the Stall Lot Manager know who will be staying for the Resort Worlds Breakaway Championship Presented By Cinch

- For the invitational contestants, the Stall Lot Manager will have your names, so please go to the stall lot office to receive your stall number.
- Every Contestant must follow these rules:
 - Coggins and Health certificates must be presented before placing horse(s) in stall(s).
 - NO outside shavings, straw or pellets are allowed as bedding. ALL IN Breakaway Roping provides one bag of shavings with 1st (first) entry. Shavings are sold onsite in the stall lot for \$10 per bag. Cash or credit cards are accepted (credit cards are subject to a 3.5% processing fee/convenience fee).
- Contestant Check In
 - Wednesday, December 7, 2022 4pm- 6pm
 - Each contestant must check-in with the office to complete paperwork and receive contestant packets, etc.
 - If you do not attend this check-in, it could result in an automatic draw out.

- Coggins and Health Certificates
 - Nevada State Livestock has the following requirements:
 - A current Health Certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian issued within 30 days of arrival.
 - A negative Coggins test performed within the previous 12 months of arrival.

Proof of ownership (for example, brand inspection certificate, bill of sale, registration paper); all livestock ENTERING and EXITING the state are required to have a current, valid brand inspection certificate from their state of origin. If your state does not provide brand inspection services, then carry proof of ownership.

- Full Western Dress code is required during all in-arena times (All 3 Rounds and Open Arena). This includes all contestants and companions that are on the arena ground. All contestants are required to wear a long sleeve collared shirt, long pants, western hat or helmet, and cowboy boots. Contestants may wear any and all individual sponsors.
- Back numbers must be worn during open arena times and in-arena competitive times.
- A rope barrier will be used with a score equaling length of box minus four feet (4'). All score lengths will be subject to Breakaway Directors or Representative approval.
- Two Timekeepers, a Field Judge, a Barrier Judge, and Spotter will be in the arena at all times.
- Bell Collar Catch only. Bell collar catch is defined as any loop passing over the calf's head and slack is drawn around the neck only. No other

appendages of the calf (i.e. front leg, tail, etc.) can be in a loop when rope breaks from the saddle horn.

- Ropes must be tied to the saddle horn of the contestant's saddle with nylon string at the VERY end of the rope. A bright colored cloth no shorter than six inches (6") must be tied to the end of the rope.
- Any unraveling of nylon string will result in disqualification.
- Only one (1) loop can be carried. A dropped loop counts as a contestant's thrown loop.
- Rope must be released from contestants' hands to qualify for catch.
- Contestants must pass through the barrier before loop is released.
- Contestants must be on horseback when time is taken.
- Once a calf crosses the score line, it belongs to the contestant. It is at the judges' discretion to give a rerun.
- 40 second time limit. :30 seconds are allowed once contestants enter the box.
- Each contestant needs to follow their calf out of the arena.
- Contestants' calf will be turned out if contestant does not enter the box by third call. This will result in a No Time.
- The Out gate will remain open in the arena at all times. Time must be taken with the calf in the arena. If any part of the calf has entered the out gate, no time will be awarded.
- Breaking the barrier will result in no time.
- The Field Judge will flag the contestant when the rope breaks away from the saddle horn.
- No time will occur if the contestant breaks the rope by hand or touches the rope or string after the catch is completed.
 - Exception to above, is if rope dallies around the saddle horn. Contestants can ride forward to un-dally and then stop to allow rope to breakaway.

- **Stock Rules**

- Calves will be chute run.
- No stock with horns will be used.

- Long Go's will pay the top 4.
- Average Payout out of 5 calves will pay the top 6

General Rules

- Entries are invitation only.
- Returned Checks
 - There will be a \$35.00 Service Charge on all returned checks from contestants, no matter what the reasoning.
 - If the check is not replaced with a Cashier's Check, Money Order or Credit/Debit card within 30 days the contestant's entry will be removed and placed on the ineligible list. Note: Credit Cards are subject to 3.5% service fee except for entry fees.
- Substitutions
 - Ropers CANNOT be substituted. Horses can be substituted.
- Tie for monies and prizes
 - In the result of a tie during any round, the award money will be split equally among the number of ties.

- In the result of a tie during any round where a prize is given, a coin flip will determine the winner of the prize. In the event of multiple ties for a prize, a drawing will be held with all contestants' names entered.
- Payout requirements
 - To receive any winnings, a completed W-9 form must be submitted at check-in or payout will be delayed or forfeited. Based on your country, different documents may be required if you are a non-US citizen. No prizes will be mailed.
- Fines
 - Any fines incurred must be paid prior to collecting any winnings.
 - Examples of fines: Poor sportsmanship, abusive actions to stock or horse during competition or on premise, damage to stall, etc.
- Disqualifications
 - Any act deemed prejudicial to the best interests of ALL IN Breakaway Roping, ALL IN Barrel Race, LLC or Group W Productions, LLC may result in the disqualification of the contestant, with no refund of entry fees. The contestant may also be placed upon the ineligible list for future ALL IN Breakaway Roping events. These acts may include but are not limited to the following:
 - Using abusive or intemperate language or attempting to threaten, bribe, influence, or harass any contestant, spectator, staff member, or arena personnel. Also, any remarks made with the intent to cast aspersions on the character or integrity of a staff or management member.
 - Tampering or attempting to adjust score lines, barrier system, roping box, roping chute, etc.
 - Use of electronic and/or remotely controlled devices to alter the outcome of a run.
 - Abuse of a horse in any way either, on the ground or in the saddle. No whipping a horse from the ground by a bystander.

- Abuse of an animal in the show arena and/or evidence that an act of abuse has occurred prior to or during the exhibition of a horse in competition.
- Competing while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- Misidentifying a rider in any round of the ALL IN Breakaway Roping competition.
- Other conduct that is not in the best interest of ALL IN Breakaway Roping, LLC, Group W Productions, LLC, or its contestants.
- Failure to make good on a returned check to ALL IN Breakaway Roping or to any other association which has a cooperative agreement with ALL IN Breakaway Roping on returned checks.
- ALL IN Breakaway Roping at their sole discretion shall have the authority to disqualify or deny entry to any horse they deem dangerous to the rider, or to other individuals, animals or property.
- Safety
 - Safety is a prime objective at this breakaway roping. If you have a horse that could be dangerous to yourself, other contestants, or other horses, DO NOT bring the horse onto the Resorts World's premise. Any horse or contestant deemed to be dangerous by the management of ALL IN Breakaway Roping, LLC or Group W Productions, LLC will be disqualified, and entry fees will not be refunded.
- Dogs
 - No dogs will be allowed on property during the event. This includes trailer parking, RV hook ups, stall lot and inside arena.
- Sportsmanship
 - All contestants and their family members are expected to display good sportsmanship at all times. No level of abuse toward any animal at this event will be allowed. Foul language, misconduct, or abusive comments spoken to any contestant, spectator, staff member, or arena personnel will

result in immediate contestant disqualification and no refund of entry fees. Contestants are also responsible for traveling companions and their family members.

- Photos and Videos
 - No commercial photography or videography from the stands unless person(s) has media credentials from ALL IN Breakaway Roping, LLC or Group W Productions, LLC.
- Rules
 - The management of ALL IN Breakaway Roping Reserves the right to create any new rule, or modify any existing rule, in order to better this event. Rules will be posted at <https://www.rodeoworld.vegas/>.
- Postponement of event
 - Resorts World Breakaway Championship reserves the right to postpone any open arena or competition time due to a natural or manmade disaster. Any monies collected will be refunded. No postponement, or cancellation, will be made due to a lack of entries.
